BEER LINE CLEANER

Description

BEERLINE is a liquid alkaline cleaner used for beer line, extractor and beer tap cleaning. BEERLINE is an effective cleaner which removes build up without tainting or leaving a residual taste in beer lines.

Benefits

- ✓ BEERLINE is simple and effective to use.
- ✓ BEERLINE is an effective product for beer line cleaning making beer line cleaning less labour intensive.
- ✓ BEERLINE does not contain surfactants therefore it will not adversely affect beer head.

Directions

- 1. Use BEERLINE at the recommended strength, i.e. 60ml per 5 litres of water.
- 2. Flush pipes with water and drain. Force solution through pipes using a manual pump, CO2 or air pressure.
- 3. Force the solution through allowing detergent to flow freely through the beer taps so the pipes are completely filled.
- 4. Shut taps and allow solution at least 15 minutes contact time.
- 5. Flush pipes with water using at least 15 litres of water per beer tap and then drain.
- 6. Clean extractor bodies, stems, short lines and parts by submerging them in the same concentration of solution as above.
- 7. Parts should then be brushed, rinsed with water and allowed to drain.

Beer Lines Should Be Cleaned At Least Once A Week

First Aid
